




### A NOW IT'S A PARTY


This river of red carries plenty of excitement, and plenty of green balances it out. But to keep things on the lively side without overcharging the senses requires some chartreuse. Think of 'Sun King' aralia (Aralia cordata 'Sun King', Zones 4–8) and Japanese forest grass (Hakonechloa macra cv., Zones 5–9) as spirited guests at this party, but not obnoxious ones.



### WHEN YOU NEED A POP, NOT A BOOM

Every garden needs areas of high interest, but when you are planting in front of a red house and behind some 'Orange Emperor' tulips (*Tulipa* 'Orange Emperor', Zones 3–8), you need to be careful. The interest here comes from the strong bottlebrush form of the euphorbias (*Euphorbia characias* ssp. *wulfenii*, Zones 7–10) and the color of their muted but still noteworthy blooms. Had the color been more yellow, the impact would have been too much.
