Brighten up your garden's shady spots with this just-released foamflower introduction. Its unique texture and year-round beauty make it an all-season winner for gardeners looking to try something new.

Throughout most of the growing season, enjoy bright-green leaves with red veining and unique white-speckled variegation. White, foamy flowers emerge from red stems in spring. And when fall arrives, the leaves change to a vibrant, autumnal pink. Gorgeous!

Foamflowers look great planted en masse or with hosta, impatiens or other shade plants. With their fast-growing, clumping habit, they help beautify borders and other small spaces.

Mystic Mist Foamy Bells

Botanical name: Tiarella 'Mystic Mist'

Size: 9 inches tall; 11 inches wide. Hardiness: Zones 4 to 9. Light: Partial or full shade.

Soil: Rich and moist.

Features: Bright-green leaves with white-speckled variegation and prominent red veins all year. In spring, pretty white blooms emerge with foam-like flowers. Foliage takes on a striking pink hue in fall.

Growing advice: Be sure to plant in moist soil that's rich in organic material. Allow adequate drainage.
