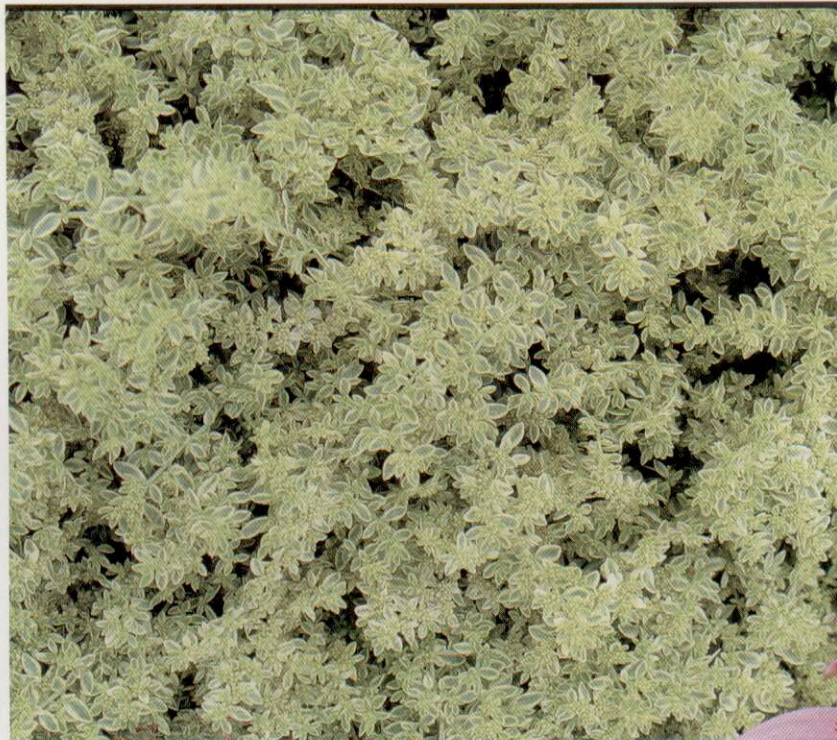

### Color every season

According to **Terra Nova**, its new coral bells plant, Plum Royale, is the first Heuchera to have shiny purple leaves all summer. Its winter foliage is silver with a purple tint, so it's usable as either an accent or en masse. Hardy in Zones 4 to 9, Plum Royale features pink-white flowers on dark peduncles, along with a mounding, compact habit. ### Delicately tough

**Stepable's** *Herniaria glabra* Sea Foam is a striped rupturewort that looks similar to an ornamental thyme, without the scent. Its demure green leaves are edged in creamy white, and its ground-hugging mat spreads to 1 ft. wide within two years. It's durable, drought-tolerant and deer-resistant, and can be used in pathways, over bulbs, in rock gardens or even surrounding roses.

### Colorful coneflower

The sun-loving, *Echinacea* Pink Double Delight from **Garden Splendor** matures to a 2-x-2-ft. coneflower that is hardy to Zone 3. It is designed for use as an individual specimen or grouped to provide drifts of distinctive, long-lasting color, equally at home in container plantings, wildflower meadows and cottage gardens. The 3-inch-wide, pompom-like flowers are carried on short, stiff stems, so they are suitable for cut flower arrangements as well. Each clump produces multiple branching stems.
