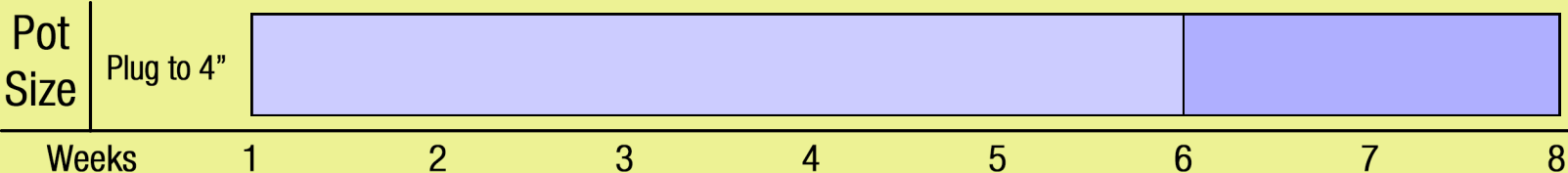


Growing Recipe

ACTAEA 'BLACK NEGLIGEE'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner
(In the spring)

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 75 PPM

EC: 0.5 - 0.7

Light Levels: Shade to part sun

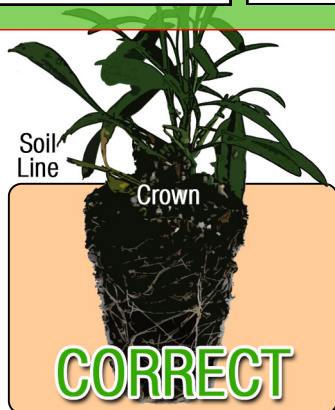
Water Requirements: Keep moist. Do not allow to dry out between waterings.

Hardiness Zones: 5 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Watch for aphids
Diseases: Few disease problems. Watch for rust.

Habit: Upright, clumping

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Description

Our customers report that 'Black Negligee' has much more vigor than the other dark varieties. Lacy black foliage just cloaks the lovely dark stems. Beautiful purple-tinted, white flowers project 2' upward and carry an exotic perfume of grape and jasmine. While it can take shade, give it full sun with lots of water in most states for the darkest foliage.
