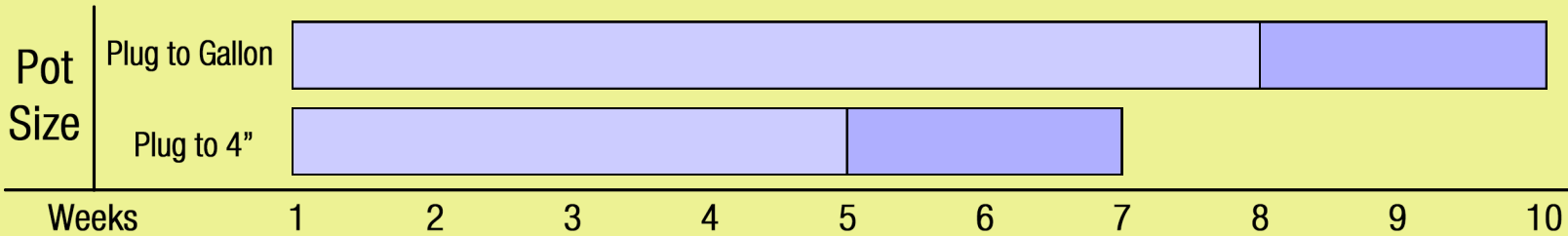


Growing Recipe

BRUNNERA 'DIANE'S GOLD'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 PPM

EC: 0.5 - 0.7

Light Levels: Filtered light to full shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

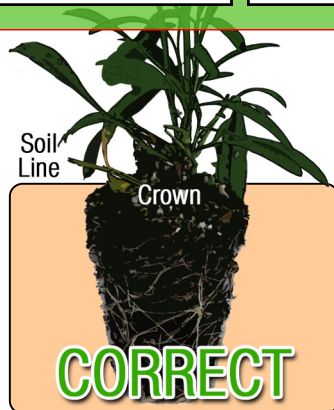
Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids are possible
Diseases: Plants seldom experience diseases

Habit: Clumping, low growing

Day Length for Flowering: Long day
