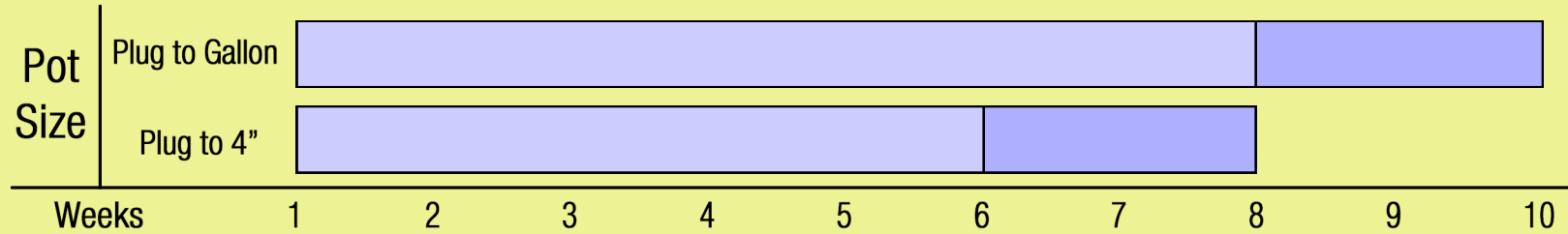


Growing Recipe

CAMPANULA 'JELLY BELLS'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 PPM

EC: 2.0

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry slightly to moderately between waterings

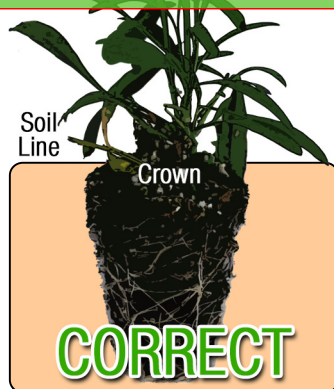
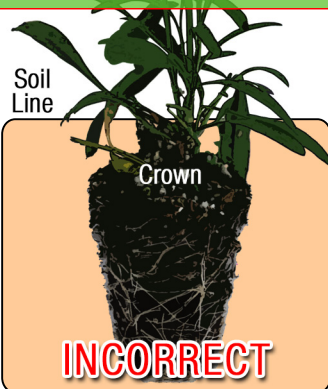
Hardiness Zones: 5 - 8

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids, snails & slugs are possible as is root rot, if it has poor drainage

Habit: Slow spreading ground cover.

Diseases: Root rot, if they don't have good drainage

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Decidedly delicious with large, deep blue-violet, nodding bells perched atop a bright green mat of foliage. It can be used in a small container or in a rock garden. 'Jelly Bells' makes a vigorous and attractive low growing perennial, returning year after year. It prefers full sun and needs good drainage.
