

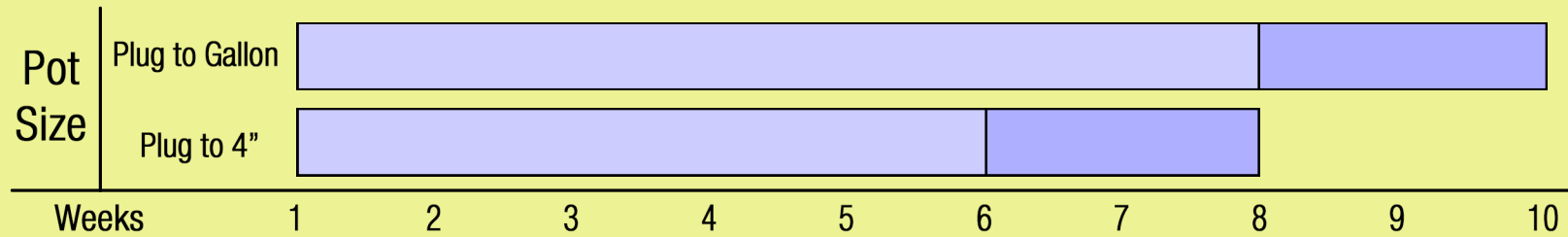


Growing Recipe

CAMPANULA 'SUMMERTIME BLUES'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.6

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 PPM

EC: 2.0

Light Levels: Full sun is best

Water Requirements: Dry slightly to moderately between waterings

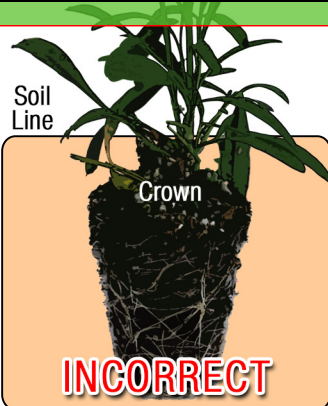
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: No major problems. May get spider mite.

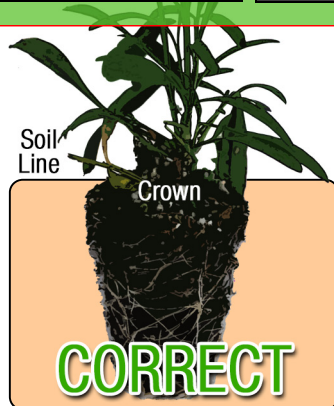
Habit: Clumping

Diseases: No major problems

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

The longest blooming Campanula we've ever seen. 'Summertime Blues' has masses of large, silvery blue bells on 2 foot, upright stems... all spring, summer and fall! A clumping habit that doesn't spread or reseed. This plant gets better each year. Here's the "cure" for the summertime blues!
