

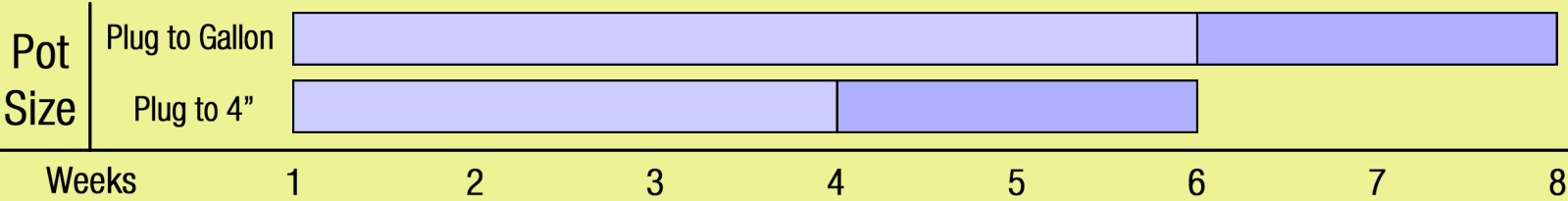


Growing Recipe

COREOPSIS 'AUTUMN BLUSH'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.75 - 1.0

Light Levels: Full sun

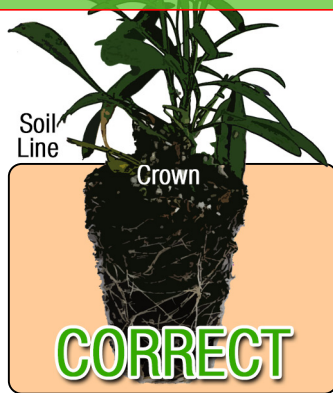
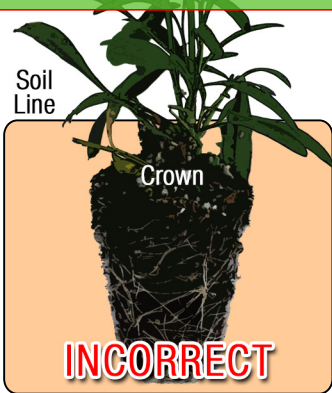
Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 6 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Snails and slugs
Diseases: No major issues. Rust and powdery mildew are possible

Habit: Mounding

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Description

This hardy hybrid out of *C. auriculata* 'Nana' begins flowering in the late spring with 2" strawberry-eyed, butter-yellow flowers. Flowers form a mid-height canopy of color, which changes as the season progresses. Cooler temperatures of fall tint the flowers a strawberry pink. Continuous flower production and vigorous growth have made 'Autumn Blush' destined to become one of American gardeners' favorite plants.
