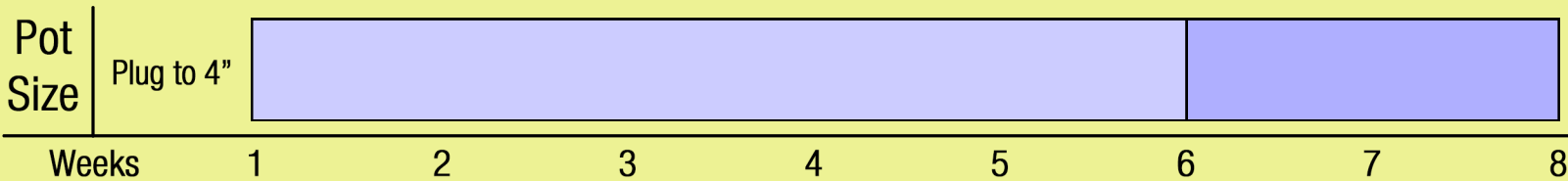


Growing Recipe

CORYDALIS 'BERRY EXCITING'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.4 - 6.6

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 - 75 PPM

EC: 0.5 - 0.7

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

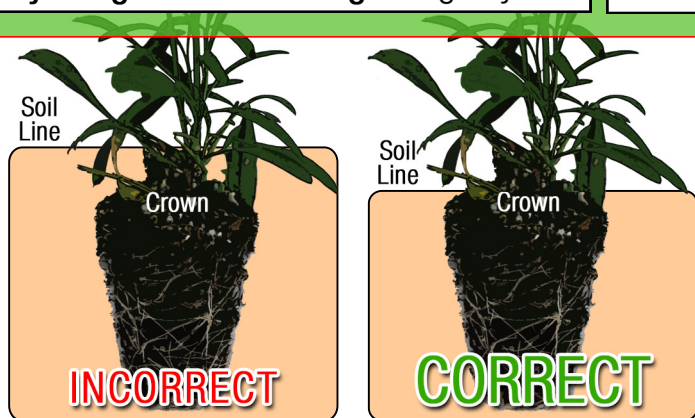
Hardiness Zones: 5 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Mites, aphids, snail and slugs are possibilities

Habit: Spreading ground cover

Diseases: Root rot, if they don't have good drainage

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Description

Brilliant yellow, fern-like leaves are streaked green and erupt in fragrant purple flowers. This wonderful mutation of C. 'Blackberry Wine' is one of the few Corydalis that does not go summer dormant. Its vigorous cascading habit makes it an excellent groundcover and looks great spilling out of baskets and over banks. We've seen it used as a different component plant and it's always a stunner in the spring garden! Takes heat and humidity!
