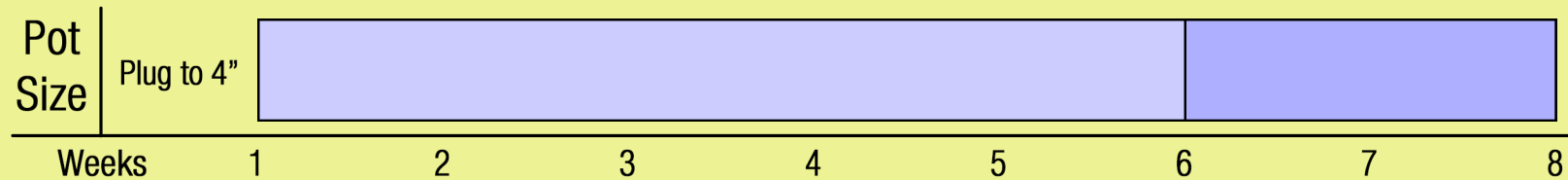


Growing Recipe

pH: 5.4 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 PPM

EC: 0.5 - 0.7

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

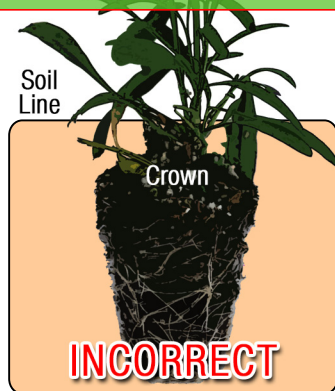
Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 5 - 9

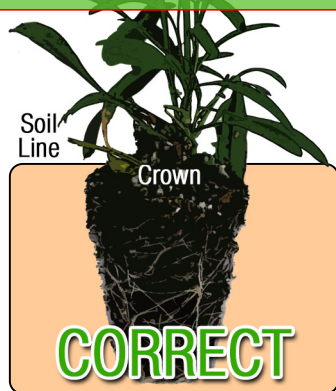
Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids and mites are a possibility
Diseases: Rust and powdery mildew are possible

Habit: Groundcover

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Description

Up before the robins in spring, this bronzy-leaved fumitory is vigorous, rhizomatous, early blooming and long lived. Plants are more compact than the standard type and are charming in the rock garden, or scrambling around stepping-stones. A great lacy contrast to Heuchera 'Lime Rickey'. Fragrant, violet-blue flowers abound in early spring. May go summer dormant.
