



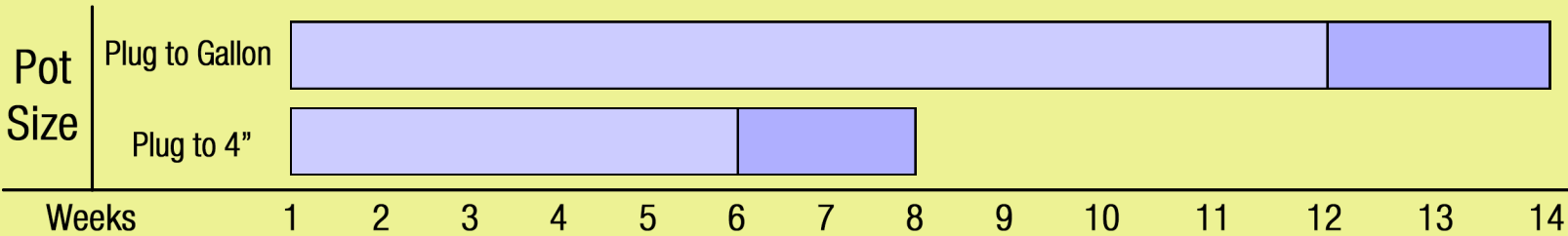
Growing Recipe

ECHINACEA 'BIG KAHUNA'

PRAIRIE PILLARS™ SERIES

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 7.3

Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs

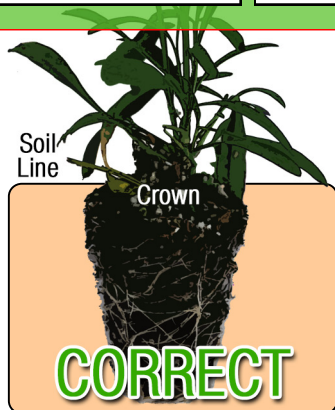
Habit: Clumping, upright

Diseases: The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Big, informal, honey-mango colored flowers in huge numbers sit above the foliage of this must have Echinacea. The sweet scent of the flowers goes right along with its Hawaiian name. 'Big Kahuna' will be the "boss" of your garden border. Sturdy, upright habit, strong stems and unique color adds up to a tropical treat.
