

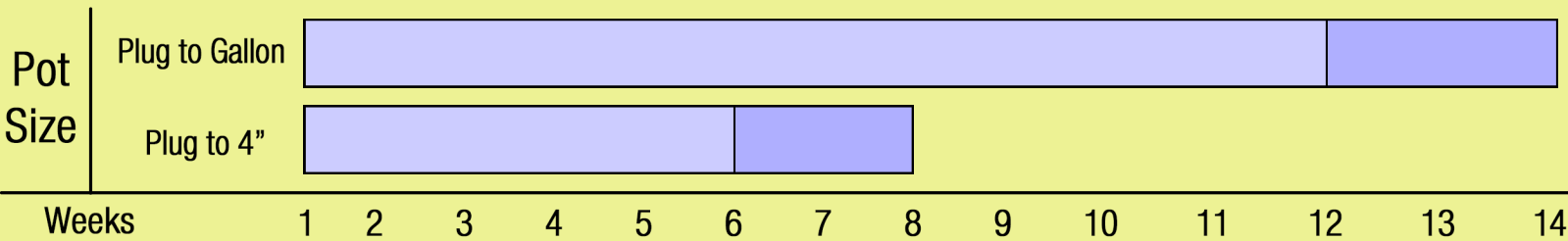


Growing Recipe

ECHINACEA 'COCONUT LIME'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 7.3

Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs

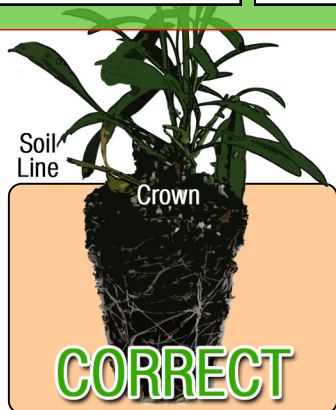
Habit: Upright

Diseases: The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

The first white double-flowering Echinacea. It has a compact habit with over 20 blooms per plant once established! The plant was discovered by well known plant breeder Arie Blom. Well-branched, sturdy flower stems are perfect for cutting! Blooms for 2-3 months! Thrives in intense heat & humidity of Texas!
