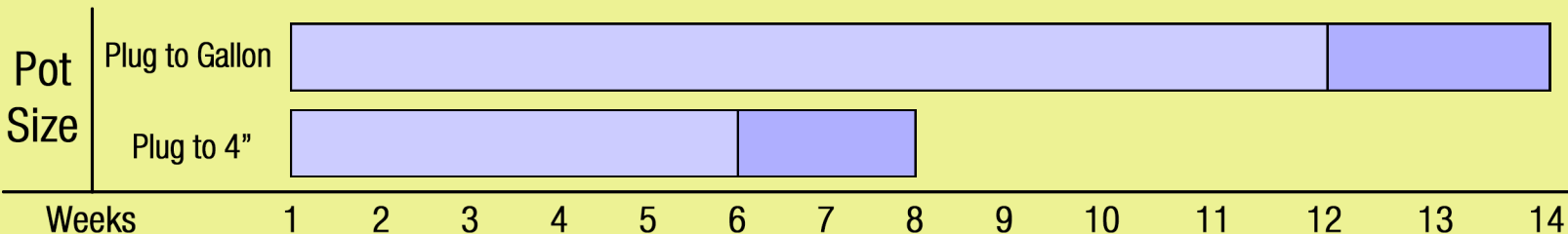


Growing Recipe

ECHINACEA 'CORAL REEF'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 7.3

Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

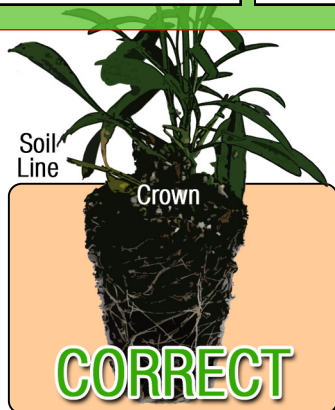
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs

Habit: Clumping

Diseases: The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Sparkles with amazing two-toned double anemone-like flowers with dark orange to coral rays topped by a coral red cone. A full sized Echinacea that is excellent as a cut-flower. A real show stopper. Its coral tones are great in combination with Agastache 'Summer Fiesta' and/or contrasting, with dark-leaved foliage like Actaea 'Black Negligee'.
