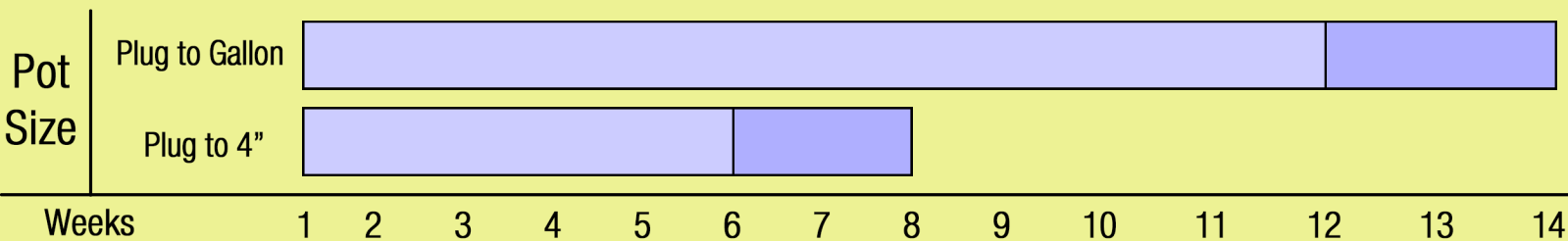


Growing Recipe

ECHINACEA 'LITTLE GIANT'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 7.3

Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM

EC: 0.7

Light Levels: Full sun

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs

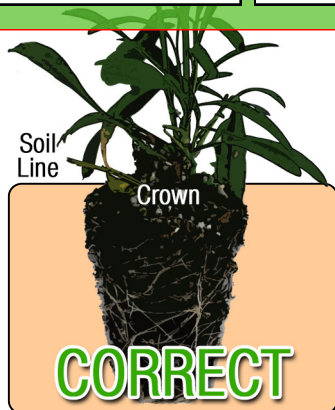
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist

Day Length for Flowering: Long day



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



Description

A dwarf coneflower with fragrant, large, purple flowers. Each of these has dark orange cones and ruffled, overlapping petals on strong stems. Many 5" flowers are produced on this long blooming gem. We counted 35 open blooms on a 2 year-old plant in our garden. Excellent for container production.
