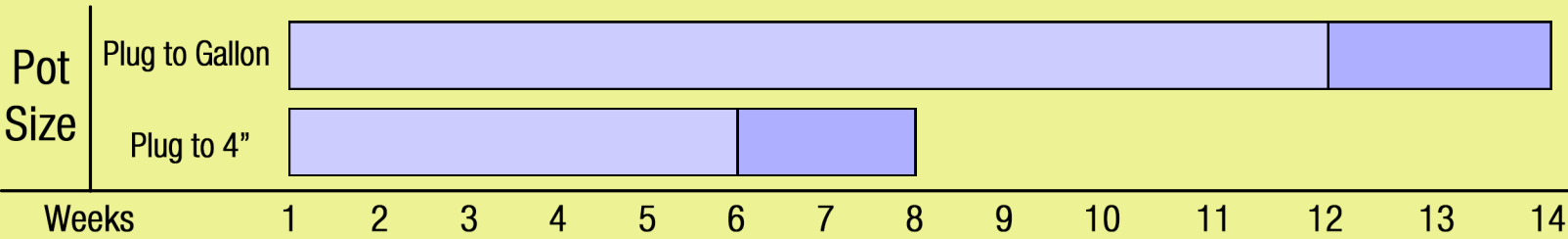

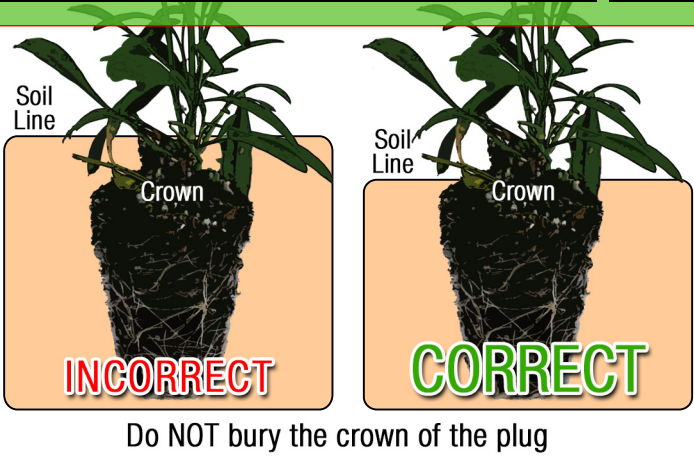
ECHINACEA 'MOAB SUNSET'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.8 - 7.3	Fertilization Recommendations: 75 - 100 PPM	EC: 0.7
Light Levels: Full sun	Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings	
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9	Possible Problems: <u>Insect</u> : Watch for aphids, mites, thrips, whitefly and slugs <u>Diseases</u> : The plants can have leaf spot and crown rot if kept too moist	
Habit: Upright		
Day Length for Flowering: Long day		



Description

This color is beyond intense. We suggest this Echinacea not be planted by roadsides to avoid distracting drivers while they text about this plant. Large, double flowers in great numbers flood this plant with color. The compact, upright habit is perfect for mid garden beds or even containers on a sunny patio. Long lasting flowers have a slow color shift, giving this plant added value throughout the summer. Superb.
