

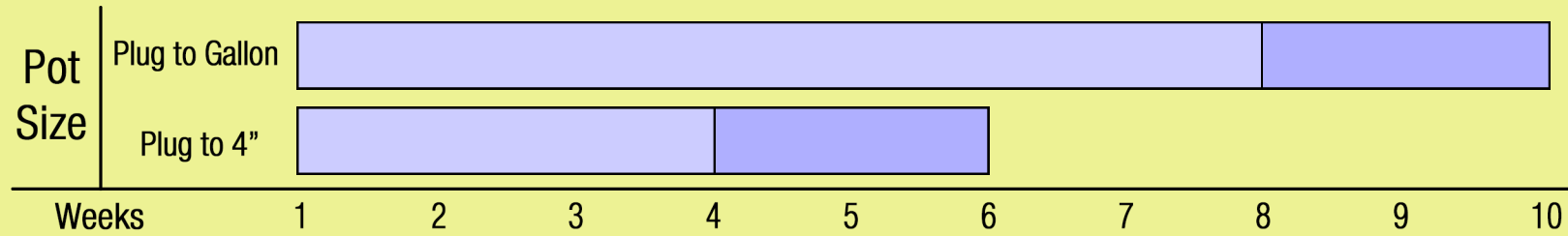


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'AUTUMN LEAVES'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

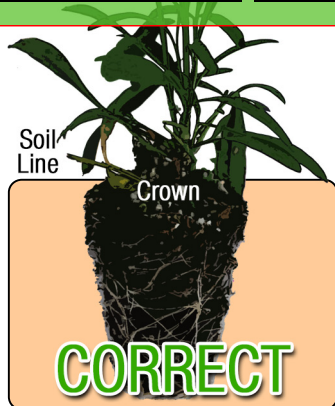
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Truly a four-seasons plant, 'Autumn Leaves' changes its personality as the days grow longer. Mid-sized leaves of red in the spring, taupe in summer, and ruby red in the fall, put on a show in any season. The *H. villosa* and *H. americana* parentage will help with heat and humidity tolerance. Try this plant in fall containers with mums and kale.
