

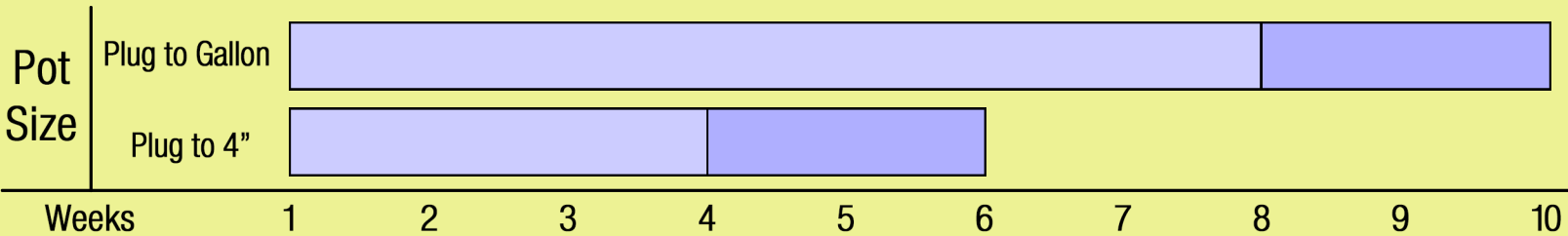


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'CAJUN FIRE'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

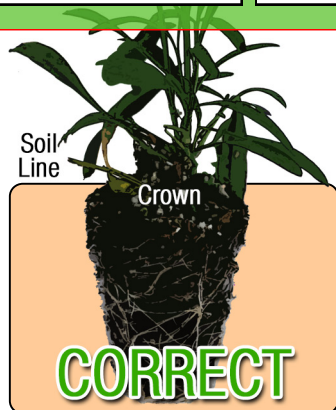
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur, not seen here.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Burning like a Cajun fire, these plants change colors with the seasons: red in spring, black in summer, and maroon in fall. They are always attractive, having clean foliage in rounded mounds. White flowers on dark stems hover just above the foliage. Grows well in the South and East as well as the Northwest!
