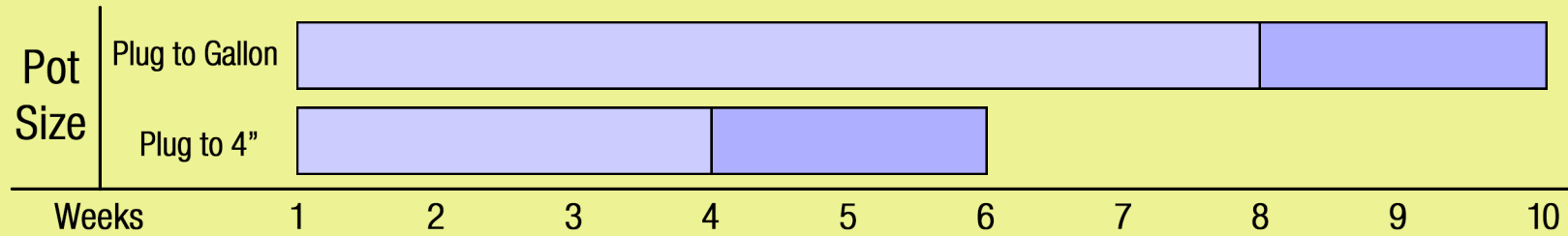


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERA 'CRÈME BRÛLÉ'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

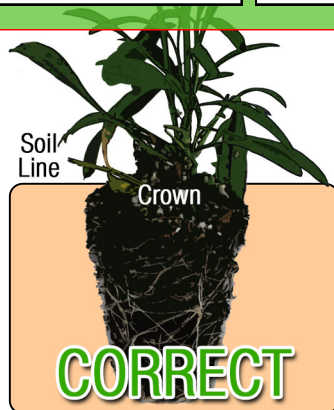
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Robust clumps are composed of peachy-orange spring leaves to amber summer leaves. Good landscape plant that grows well in the Pacific Northwest and is listed as one of the 4 best ambers for the south.
