

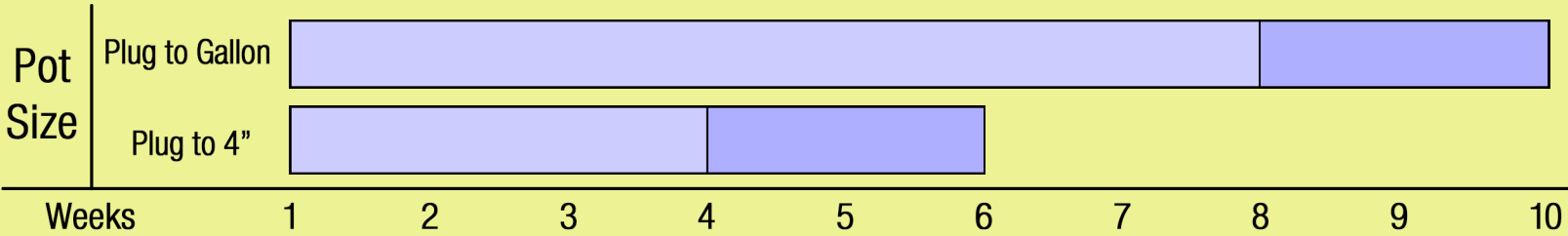

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

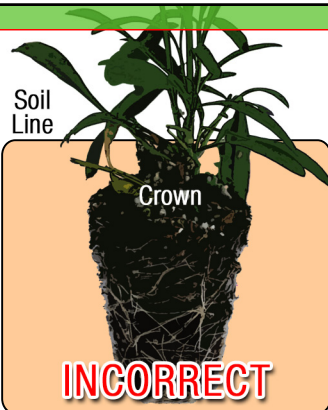
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

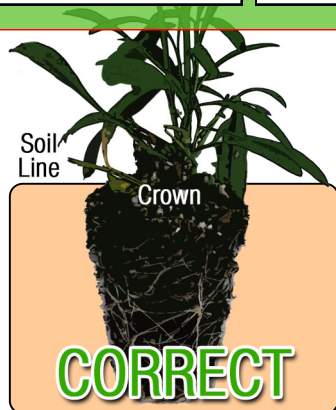
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Bred to fill landscapes! This large leaf H. villosa hybrid has a big mounding habit with purple, wavy leaves. Flowers on medium height stalks are not messy making it a lovely landscape or container plant. It performs extremely well in Oregon and should perform great in the midwest, east and south.
