

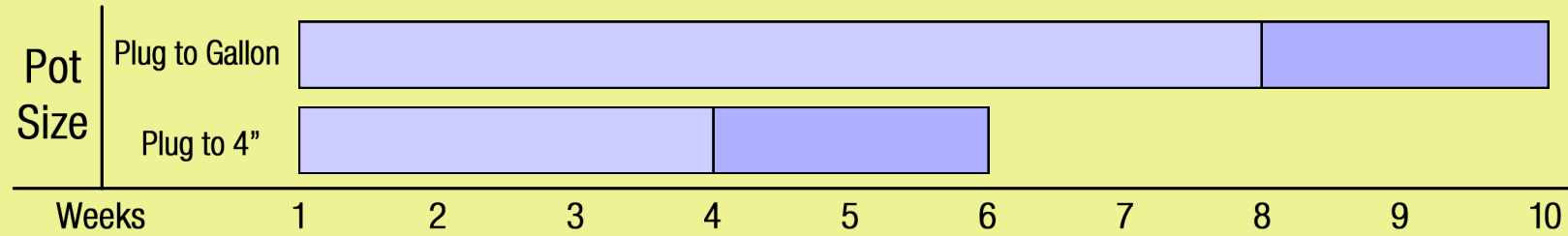

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

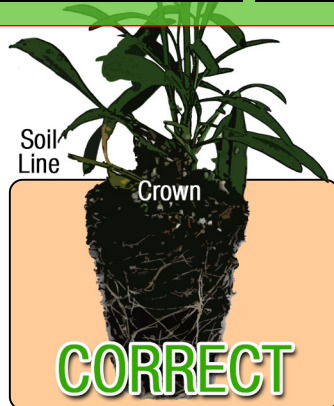
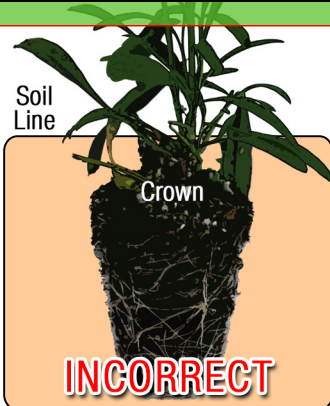
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Round leaves in clear, dark red adorn the dense, medium size mounds. This showy garden plant was bred from hardy species and looks good longer in the season than other Heuchera. Great rust resistance.
