



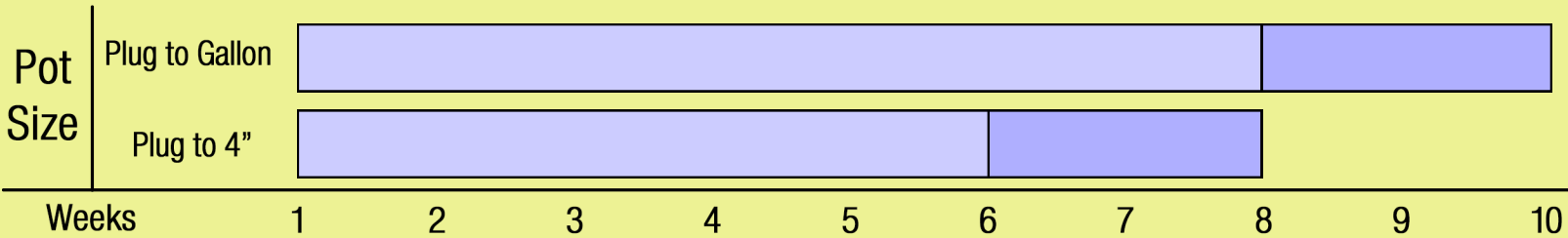

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

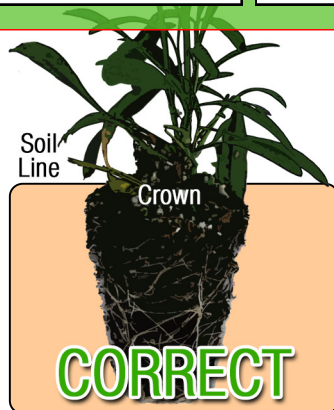
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Crisp, fresh green leaves in the spring and fall blending to a beautiful sienna orange in the summer. This showy garden plant was bred from hardy *H. richardsonii* and looks good longer in the season than other Heuchera. Long lived, hardy, and rust resistant, this plant is perfect for maintaining clear lines in the landscape.
