

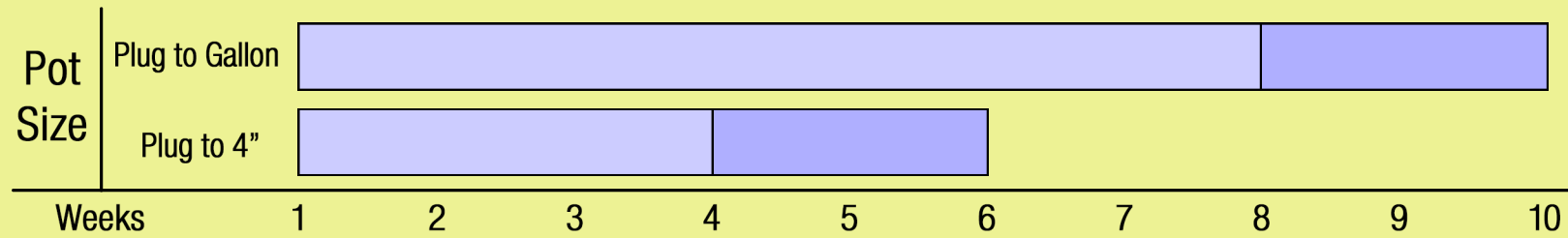

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

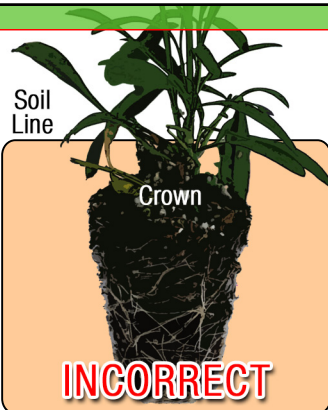
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas.

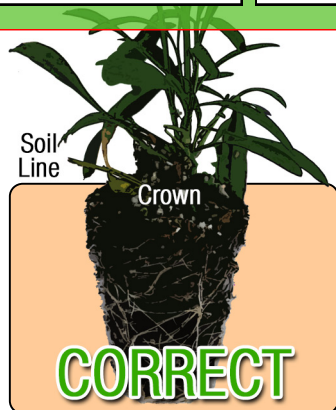
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. Botrytis may occur in high humidity environments.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral
