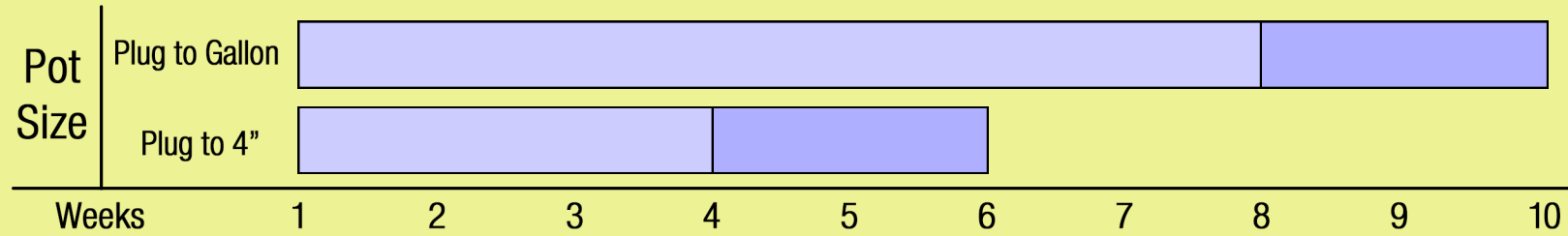


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERELLA 'MOJITO'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

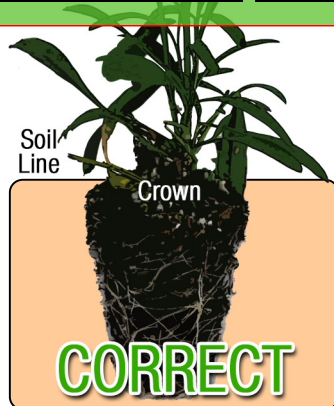
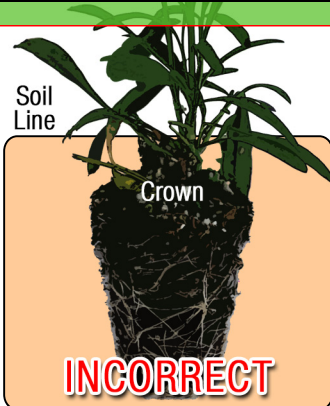
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: **Insect:** Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. **Note:** All Heucherella are rust resistant.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Warm gold spring color gives way to summer lime, always with red veins that hold their color well into the season. Dense, compact habit. Short petioles give this plant a unique fullness. It's always neat with few or no flower spikes for easy maintenance.
