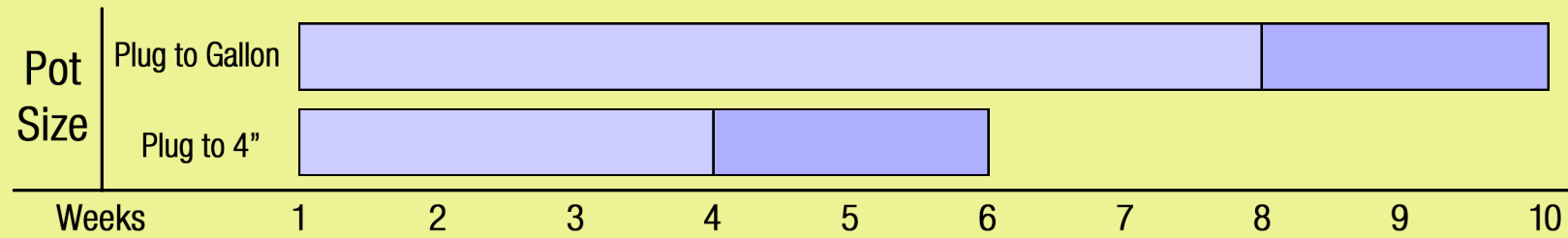


# Growing Recipe

# HEUCHERELLA 'ONYX'

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

☐ = Minimum ☐ = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

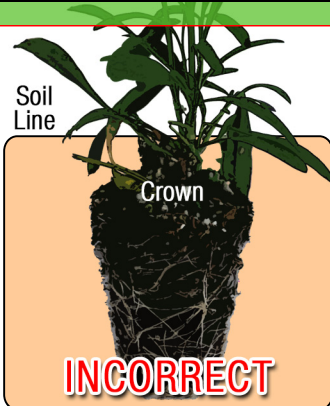
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas and watch for root weevils.

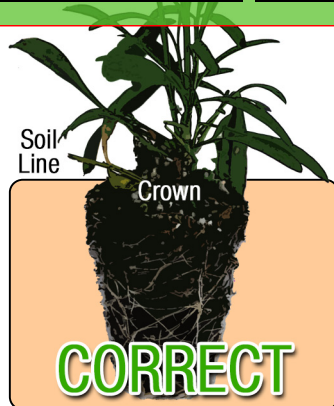
Habit: Mound

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. **Note**: All Heucherella are rust resistant.

Day Length for Flowering: Short Day

True black, glossy, deeply cut leaves on a dense medium size mound make this a great landscape plant. We've been working for years to get a good black Heucherella. This is it. Loves heat and humidity but great in the northwest. Shy to bloom - always stays neat and clean. Great foliage for mixed containers.
