

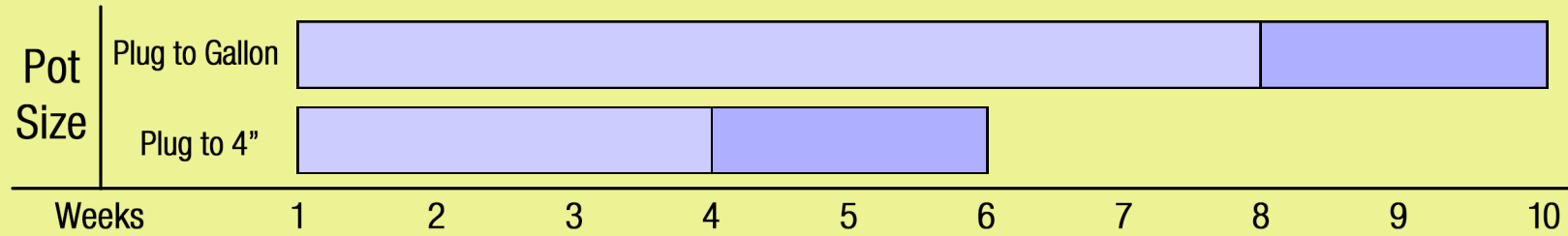


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERELLA 'SOLAR POWER'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas and watch for root weevils.

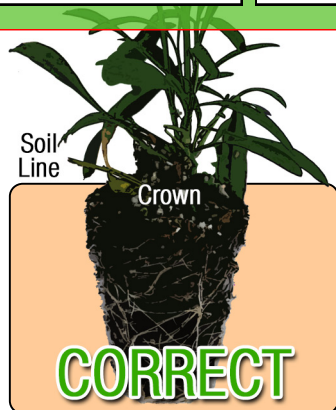
Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. **Note**: All Heucherella are rust resistant.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral



Do NOT bury the crown of the plug



Description

The lobed yellow gold to lime green leaves are splattered with deep red. It forms a large mound of color in part shade or shade. This Heucherella takes higher light levels than any yellow Heuchera or Heucherella we've seen. It did fine in 90-100° F temps in full sun in our black ground cloth covered trial beds! When grown in full shade it stays lime green with splatters of deep red.
