## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.25 - 2.5

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

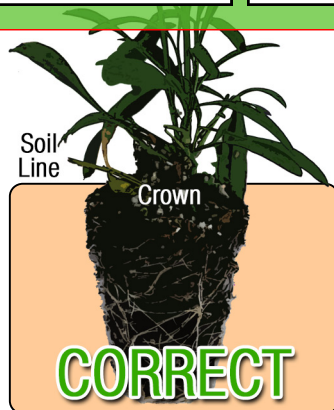
Water Requirements: Provide frequent watering

Hardiness Zones: 6 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: No major problems  
Diseases: Rust can be an issue

Habit: Spreading groundcover

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

## Description

A wild sport collected at 1500' in the Northwest by Chuck Pavlich. Shimmering metallic golden "palms", which can grow to almost 3 feet wide, arise in early spring preceded by cream colored male flower spikes from February to April. Thrives in moist conditions. Requires shade in southern climes and needs sun elsewhere for best color. This is a spreader. Offered as bare root only.
