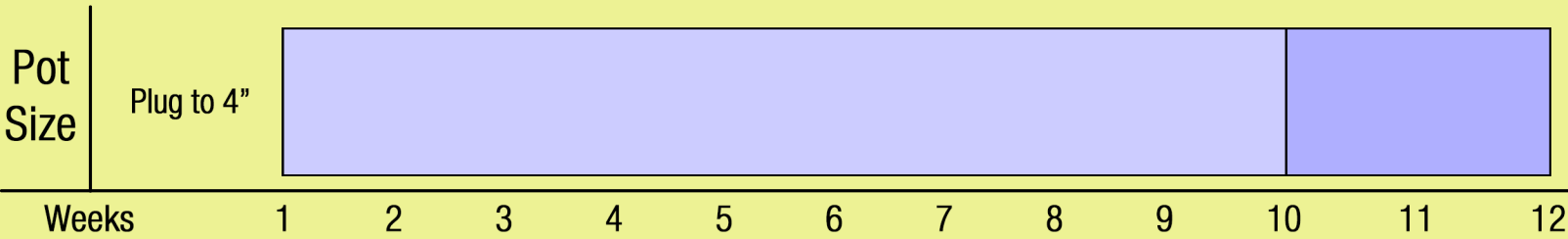


Growing Recipe

PODOPHYLLUM 'SPOTTY DOTTY'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.6 - 6.6

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.0 - 1.5

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry only very slightly between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 6 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: None

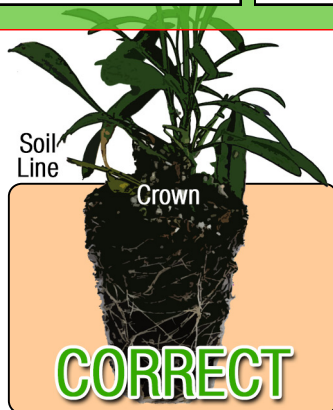
Habit: Slow spreader

Diseases: Root rot is possible if drainage is not good

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

This brilliant hybrid of several Asian Mayapples boasts large, vigorous, lobed umbrella-like leaves. New leaves are chartreuse with dramatic chocolate-brown spotting. In summer, the leaves are green with lightly spotted areas. Large garnet red flowers are found under the leaves in clusters of 5 or more. 'Spotty Dotty' was selected for its coloring, frost tolerance, vigor, and rhizomatous habit. All Podophyllum prefer shade and cool, moist, organic soils. Protect from hard frosts in spring. Avoid drought stress.
