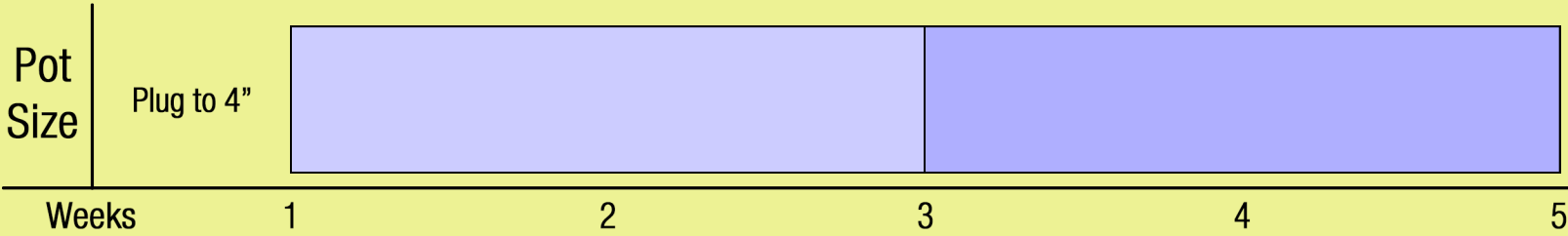


Growing Recipe

POLEMONIUM 'STAIRWAY TO HEAVEN'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.8 - 2.2

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 3 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids are possible

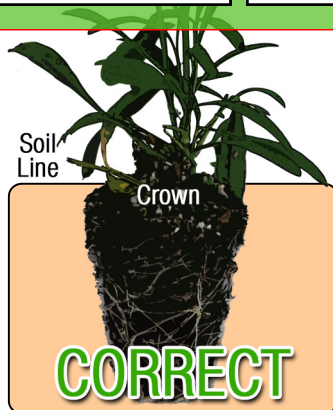
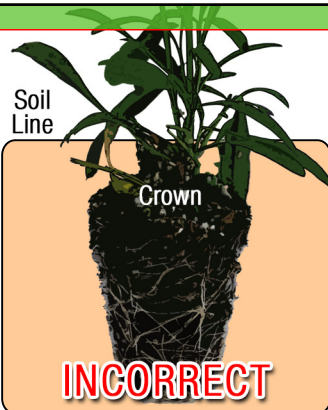
Diseases: Powdery mildew

Habit: Mounding

Day Length for Flowering: Long day

Description

Broad, bold, cream variegated foliage with 12 inch stems bearing light blue flowers from May-June. It's a very hardy large-leaved Polemonium introduced by Bill Cullina of the New England Wild Flower Society. The pink leaf tones during cool periods adds interest. It's much bolder and more showy in foliage than Polemonium 'Snow and Sapphires', however the flowers are more visually interesting on 'Stairway to Heaven'.
