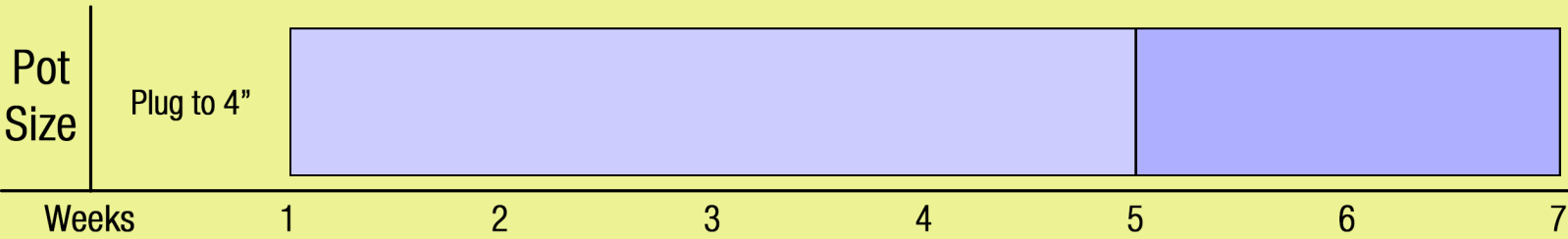


Growing Recipe

PULMONARIA 'REGINALD KAYE'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.0 - 2.0

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

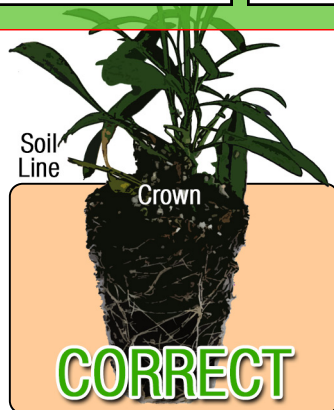
Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids, slugs are possible
Diseases: Botrytis can be a problem if the foliage is kept too moist. Leaf spot.

Habit: Clumping

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

The speckled silvered foliage and outstanding vigor make this a great plant for American gardens. Flower spikes have tightly packed heads of pinkish red buds, which open to violet flowers.
