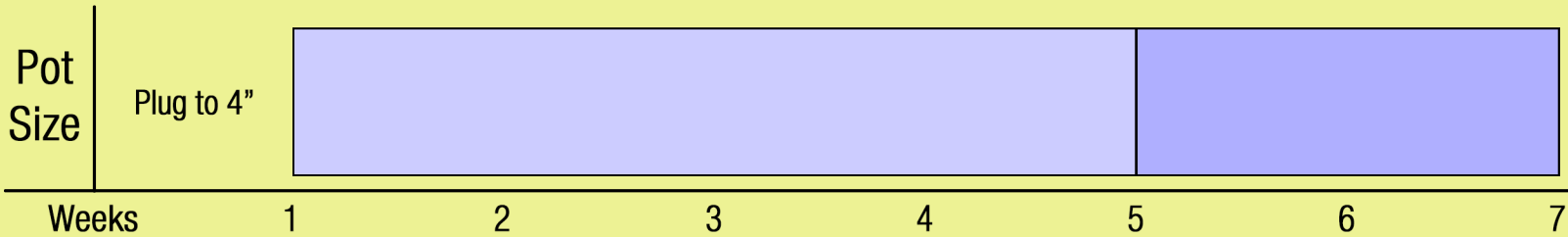


Growing Recipe

PULMONARIA 'SILVER SCIMITAR'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.0 - 2.0

Light Levels: Part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

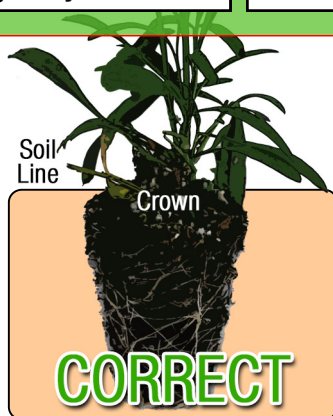
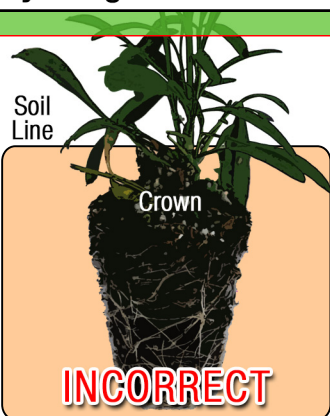
Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids, slugs are possible
Diseases: Botrytis can be a problem if the foliage is kept too moist. Leaf spot.

Habit: Clumping

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Large arching silver green foliage with wavy edged strap like foliage. Full landscape sized plant, vigorous and fast, 'Silver Scimitar' has a stately presence. Emerges each spring in a tight mound covered in bicolor pink and purple flowers, an early season hummingbird favorite. Performs well in both shade and full sun, perfect for borders and edges.
