
## Growing Recipe ZANTEDESCHILA EDGE OF NIGHT



**pH:** 6.0 - 7.0

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: --

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 8 - 11

Possible Problems: Insect: No major pests

Habit: Upright, clumping

<u>Diseases:</u> Erwinia is the main problem, in warm, wet conditions. Once infected, no cure. Keep Ca levels up and N levels low to help prevent infection.

Day Length for Flowering: Long day
